All General Rules & Regulations Apply. Please Read Them Carefully.

ENTRIES

1. Open to any Junior or Senior 4-H member or FFA member in good standing, duly certified and currently conducting a 4-H or FFA horse project. Exhibitors must have reached their 9th birthday and NOT have reached their 19th birthday on January 1, 2012. Juniors are those who have not reached their 14th birthday prior to January 1, 2012. Seniors are those who have reached their 14th birthday prior to January 1, 2012. Ranch Sorting is a single class, All-Ages, 4-H only. There will not be separate Junior and Senior division classes.
2. All classes will be conducted under the current Arizona State 4-H Horse Show Rules. **All exhibitors are responsible for knowing these rules.** Arizona State 4-H Horse Show rules are available online at <http://extension.arizona.edu/4h/stateprojects/animal-science/horse>
3. Exhibitors must submit the 4-H/FFA Horse Show Entry Form, complete with all the required signatures and entry fees by **December 10**. Exhibitors submitting complete entries postmarked or received by **November 15** will receive an ANLS Exhibitor T-Shirt. Photocopied entry forms are acceptable. The entry form can be found in the Horse Show Premium Book and is also available online at www.anls.org/Horse/rules/. **Ranch Sorting must enter using a Ranch Sorting Entry Form.**
4. Only one rider per horse per class.
5. In accordance with 4H/FFA rules, only 4H/FFA members will be allowed to ride/exercise their horses on the grounds.
6. Stallions may not be entered in any 4-H/FFA Horse Show classes.
7. Show Management reserves the right to cancel or change classes and address any safety issues. Show management decisions are final.

FEES

8. Western, English & Gymkhana - \$8.00 per class
Roping Classes - \$15.00 per class includes cattle
Ranch Sorting - \$16.00 per entry plus \$10.00 cattle fee per exhibitor
Exhibitor Fee - \$10.00 per exhibitor.
9. For Western, English, Gymkhana and Roping entries, late entries or substitutions will be allowed after the December 10 entry deadline with a \$5.00 per class late fee. Day of Show entries may be accepted until 8:00 am with a \$10.00 per class late fee. Late entries WILL NOT be accepted for Ranch Sorting classes.
10. No refunds will be made after entries close. Refund of class fees or stall fees will be considered if the Chairman is notified prior to 8:00 am the day of the class being dropped, and a qualified veterinarian's statement is provided which indicates the lack of soundness or serviceability of the horse. Exhibitor fees and stall deposits are Not Refundable.
11. All fees must accompany entries. Make check payable to *Arizona National* and mail with entry form to: Arizona National Livestock Show, 1826 West McDowell Road, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. A service fee of \$35.00 will be charged on all returned checks.

12. Exhibitors entered by November 15 will receive an ANLS Exhibitor T-Shirt. Exhibitors entering after the November 15 deadline will still pay the exhibitor fee, but will not receive a T-Shirt.

STALLS

13. See General Rules for Stall Rules and Stall Fees. Horses requiring a stall that are entered in both the 4-H and AQHA shows must reserve stalls under the Quarter Horse Show.
14. Stall fees for the 4H/FFA show are \$50 first day, \$25 additional for second day.
- 15. Shavings are NOT included, please see Stall section of General Rules**
- 16. 4H/FFA stalls must be reserved on the 4-H/FFA entry form.**

AWARDS

17. Awards are given for 1st place. Rosettes are awarded for 1st through 10th place in all classes.
18. Junior and Senior Hi-Point and Reserve Hi-Point awards are given in each discipline. These disciplines are Roping (100 classes), Gymkhana (200 classes), English (300 classes), and Western (400 classes). An award will be given to each team member on the Hi-Point and Reserve Hi-Point Ranch Sorting teams.
19. Awards include Hi-point buckles sponsored through the Arizona National and Reserve Hi-point cantle plates sponsored by AAEC High Schools.

POINTS

20. Points will be awarded for the top 10 places, (10-9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1) regardless of the number of contestants in the class. Ties for high point awards will be broken by the most number of 1st places. If still tied, most number of 2nd places, continuing until tie is broken.
