2019 RULE CHANGES AND DEADLINES

Deadlines

- Jr Breeding Gilts entries due November 15

Schedule

- The Junior Livestock Judging Contest has been moved to December 30

General

- No propane tanks in barns
- No signage larger than 8"x10" may be displayed without Show Management approval

Fees

- Early Bird Arrival on December 26 for junior exhibitors
 - \$250/trailer
- In lieu of the Junior Exhibitor and Drug Testing Fee; Junior Cattle, Sheep, Goat and Swine entry fees have been raised by \$5/hd
- Animal Entry - Late Entry Fee schedule
 - 1-7 days after entry deadline: \$250.00
 - 8+ days after entry deadline: \$500.00
- Incomplete Entry
 - Exhibitor will be notified of an incomplete entry and given a deadline to complete the entry. If the deadline is missed, exhibitor will be charged \$25/incidence
- Judging Contest
 - No entries accepted after December 28
 - No late fees
- Skill-A-Thon - Late Entry Fee
 - 1-15 days after entry deadline: \$100.00
 - No entries accepted after December 26

Animal Health

- One CVI per family/farm per specie
- The Show Veterinarian or the Director of Livestock may remove or quarantine an animal at their discretion.

Open Cattle

- There must be a minimum of eight (8) head of cattle stalled and shown to make a breed show. If less than eight (8) head, the breed may show in the All Other Breeds division.
- Open Cattle exhibitors will be required to email copies of registration papers on animals entered by December 15, 2019

Junior Show General Rules

- Quality Assurance - All exhibitors in the Junior Show are required to have completed a state or national Quality Assurance training/course.

Junior Cattle

- Prospect/Progress Cattle division has been broken into two Divisions
 - Prospect Cattle – cattle weighing 350 to 999 lbs.
 - Progress Cattle – cattle weighing 1000 lbs. and over
- Prospect/Progress Steers exhibitors will submit weight cards
- Opt into AOC – Exhibitors with two steers which may classify into the same color division may choose to classify one into the AOC division
- Limit the number of Market Steers shown – Exhibitors may check-in and show four (4) market steers

Junior Sheep

- Change Market Wether show to five divisions based on weight, remove classification by breed/color
- Exhibitors will be allowed to shear sheep on the show grounds
- Sheep will be presented for inspection of fungus to an animal health committee

Junior Goat

- Exhibitors will be allowed to shear goats on the show grounds
- Delete maximum show weight; maximum sale weight to remain at 120 lbs.
- Goats will be presented for inspection of fungus to an animal health committee

Junior Swine

- Swine will be penned two (2) per pen

Junior Sale of Champions

- An exhibitor will be allowed to sell only one animal in the Sale of Champions unless they exhibited more than one Grand and/or Reserve Champion in one or more species

Master Showmanship

- Revised to include a round robin showmanship contest only

Rose Mofford Award

- Change structure of award to an application open to Arizona Junior exhibitors

Public Speaking

- Public Speaking contest is open to any exhibitor 22 years of age or younger, no organization affiliation is required
- Participants in the Public Speaking Contest may choose any current subject of an agricultural nature for their speech

Ag Mechanics

- Ag Mechanics is open to any exhibitor 22 years of age or younger, no organization affiliation is required
