Open Cattle

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • There will not be a progress steer show, all steers weighing 1000 lbs. and more will be entered in the Market Steer show, DNA samples will be required 	
Junior Sheep	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Market Lambs will be shown by color/breed (i.e. Black, White, South Down, Natural Colored, Fine Wool) • Tooth rule has been eliminated 	88

2022 Summary of Policy Changes

Fire Marshall Regulations
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All generators and propane heaters will be placed within established areas. Significant fines and/or confiscation by the Fire Marshall may be imposed on violators. • All portable tents will be set up within established boundaries, no propane heaters will be allowed inside of tents.
