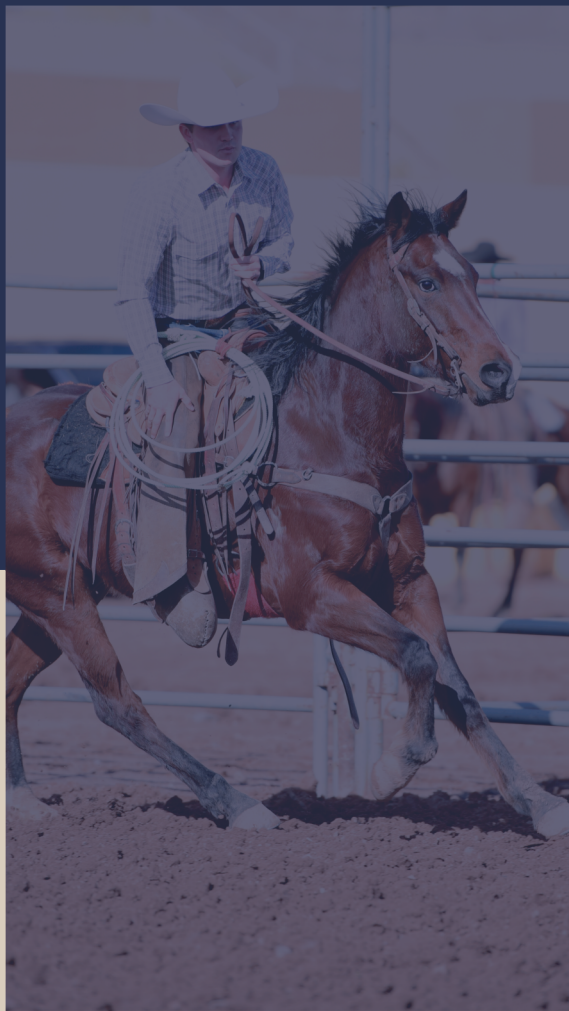

CONTESTANT MEETING: 9:30 a.m., December 29

CONTEST: 10:30 a.m., December 29

DEPARTURE DEADLINE: Livestock must be removed by 4:00 p.m., January 1, 2023

The objective of the Arizona National Ranch Rodeo is to provide a contest for ranches to exhibit and compete in the day to day events of a working ranch. The Arizona National Livestock Show reserves the right to accept or reject any entry at its sole discretion.

ENTRIES/STALLS

1. Entries and fees must be received in the Arizona National Livestock Show Office on or before **December 11**.
2. Entry fee is \$500.00 per team.
3. Entries are limited to one (1) team per ranch. Additional entries from the same ranch will be considered if the entry limit has not been met ten (10) days following the entry deadline.
4. All contestants must sign a Release of Liability before the event.
5. Pens will be available to overnight horses \$35 per pen.

CONTEST FORMAT

1. Each team will consist of four (4) riders
2. There will be a four (4) minute time limit to brand one yearling, doctor one yearling, tie one horned steer and load one horned steer:
 - a. Team will start behind designated line.
 - b. Four (4) head of cattle will be turned out into arena (two horned steers and two yearlings).
 - c. Time will start when last calf enters the arena and the flagger drops the flag.

- d. One horned steer will be caught and tied down before the second horned steer is loaded. Tied steer must remain tied down until other horned steer is loaded, ropes off, gates closed and unloaded before being let up. If tied down steer gets up before other steer is loaded and unloaded, it will result in a no time.
- e. One yearling will be doctored by marking it between the eyes with designated marker.
- f. Second yearling will be caught and laid flat on right side and branded on left rib.
- g. Once all cattle have been worked, up on feet and freed from ropes, team will clear cattle out of arena and close gate to stop time.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

1. A negative Coggins, dated within the previous twelve (12) months, must accompany all horses brought onto the Arizona State Fairgrounds.
